A satellite conference of the 5th European Congress of Mathematics 2008

The conference will take place in Cluj-Napoca, Romania, and the venue will be the Babeş-Bolyai University. The arrival and departure days are Sunday, July 7, and Sunday, July 13, respectively. On Saturday, July 12, a one-day trip will be organized to Sibiu (European Capital of Culture 2007). Alongside the main lectures, there will be a number of short talks in parallel sessions. The registration and submission of abstracts starts on February 15, 2008, and the deadline is May 15, 2008.

# How to reach Cluj:

- by plane: As of February 1, 2008, there are direct flights connecting Cluj to Ancona, Athens, Barcelona, Bari, Bergamo, Bologna, Bucharest, Budapest, Dortmund, Düsseldorf, Florence, Frankfurt, London, Madrid, Milan, Munich, Rome, Stuttgart, Torino, Venice, Verona, Vienna. Please check the Cluj Airport web site (http://www.airportcluj.ro/en/hpg.html) for updated information and contact your travel agent.
- by train: Cluj is about 7 hours from Bucureşti (Bucharest), and 6 hours from Budapest, Hungary. For timetables we recommend the DB web site (http://reiseauskunft.bahn.de/bin/query.exe/en?)
- by car: If you travel from Western Europe, take motorway M1 from Wien to Budapest, then
   European Route E60 for Budapest Szolnok Püspökladány Ártánd/Borş (border crossing)
   Oradea Cluj.

Currency: The local currency is Romanian Lei (RON). Many exchange offices close to the city center offer good rates for Euro, US Dollar or Hungarian Forint.

Visa: EU, US and Canada citizens do not need a visa to enter Romania. In other cases please contact the Romanian Embassy in your country, or check the web site of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.
